**MEETING WITH BLACK ROCK VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY**

1. General Introductions and Meeting Purpose

2. Define Township's 2-3 Year Vision For Township-wide Emergency Services

We should state in no uncertain terms that the Township has plans to build a centralized Emergency Management Facility at the Black Rock Campus within the next 2-3 years, which will house both fire and ambulance operations. During this interim period, the Township will be looking to align itself with a fire company to help staff a combination department under the leadership of the Fire and Emergency Services Chief. We should ask the BRVFC leadership if they are interested in being considered and what they can bring to the table.

3. Review Chain of Command and Communication Ground Rules Moving Forward

You can defer to Josh to explain the new chain of command structure, as authorized under Chapter 85. He will have an organizational chart on the screen to help explain the new command structure.

4. Review BRVFC Standards and Concerns

This will be an opportunity for Josh and Bryan to offer some statistics regarding BRVFC's response record to emergencies and identifying Township concerns. Give the BRVFC leadership the opportunity to respond to these concerns. Give them the opportunity to state their reasons why they should be the chosen agency with the Township should align itself when the new centralized facility goes
